Revised Notice of Public Meetings Facilitated Dialogue Sessions

The Rent Stabilization Program is issuing this revised notice of public meetings changing the dates and locations previously published regarding the upcoming facilitated dialogue sessions.

The City of Beverly Hills Rent Stabilization Program will conduct a series of facilitated dialogue sessions to share information on policy issues relative to the rent stabilization ordinance. Consultant HR&A Advisors, Inc. (HR&A) will provide their evaluation of policy issues to obtain public input. A total of three meetings are scheduled and will be facilitated by Professor Sukhsimranjit Singh. HR&A will provide a summary overview of their findings at these meetings, which also includes policy options. Tenants and Housing Providers are encouraged to attend all three meetings as each meeting will cover different topics.
