Beverly Hills Looks Ahead to the Next One Hundred Years *Time Capsule Dedication slated as the finale for the City's Centennial Celebrations*

The City of Beverly Hills will culminate its year-long Centennial celebration with a Time Capsule Dedication on Sunday, January 25, 2015, from 2 p.m. – 3 p.m. at Will Rogers Park, located at 9650 Sunset Boulevard. Everyone in the community is invited to attend the free event.

Hosted by the City of Beverly Hills City Council, and Centennial Committee, the event will include the dedication of the time capsule, which will be buried in the Centennial rose bush planters behind the Will Rogers Park monument sign on N. Canon Dr. and N. Beverly Dr.

“A time capsule is a very fitting way to memorialize Beverly Hills’ Centennial year,” commented Nancy Hunt-Coffey, Assistant Director of the Community Services Department. “No one knows what the community will look like in 100 years, but we want Beverly Hills residents of the future to enjoy a glimpse of local life in 2014, which has been one memorable year!”

The City celebrated its 100th birthday with a variety of local events and community activities paying tribute to the past, present, and future of Beverly Hills. Centennial themed highlights included a float in the Tournament of Roses parade, the BH100 Block Party on Rodeo Drive, Lily Pond dedication, Arts of Palm installation, tree and rose plantings, a commemorative photography exhibit, cookbook, youth art and stamp contest, and a centennial book.

Contents submitted for the time capsule include newspaper clippings, photos and Beverly Hills Centennial souvenirs. Light refreshments will be served at the time capsule dedication, which will continue rain or shine. Free street parking is available around Will Rogers Park. No RSVP’s required.
