NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCIES:

RENT STABILIZATION COMMISSION - AT-LARGE MEMBERS ONLY

The Beverly Hills City Council is seeking qualified residents to fill three vacancies on the Rent Stabilization Commission (RSC) for **At-Large** members only. An At-Large member is defined as someone who is not a Tenant, not a Manager of an apartment building, and not a Housing Provider who has a financial interest of 5% or more in a multi-family residential rental property (apartment building) either within or outside of the City of Beverly Hills. Two At-Large Commissioners and one At-Large Alternate Commissioner will be selected.

The initial term of office for the position is for two years. At the discretion of the City Council, the RSC Commissioners may be reappointed to a second term of four years. The appointees will be required to file an initial and an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" financial disclosure.

In order that we may preserve the integrity of the application and interview process, please direct all inquiries to the City Clerk, City Manager, Deputy Director of Rent Stabilization, or the Director of Community Development. Please **DO NOT** contact the City Councilmembers regarding the vacancies.
