**2) INITIAL ANALYSIS OF AND BACKGROUND ON POSSIBLE AMENITIES AT LA CIENEGA PARK AND RECREATION COMPLEX.**

Community Services Director Nancy Hunt Coffey and Principal Architect from Johnson Favaro, Jim Favaro, presented an initial study plan on La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex, which staff will present to the full City Council on December 18, 2018.

The high school construction plans were briefly reviewed and all agreed not to focus on their construction but to move ahead with the La Cienega Park design.

All reviewed and discussed the passive green space with the possibility of additional fields, buildings on one or both sides of the park; parking on the east side, a gymnasium, two swimming pools and unprogrammed play space. The typography of the park was discussed.

Future meetings will provide more detail on proposed amenities such as the swimming pools in addition to a bridge over La Cienega Boulevard vs. subterranean.
