- 2) Request for Funding and Street Closures for the Rodeo Drive Concours d'Elegance Beverly Hills Father's Day Car Show on Sunday, June 19, 2022
  - a. Support was given for the street closures impacting Rodeo Drive, Crescent Drive, as well as portions of Brighton Way and Dayton Way that are adjacent to Rodeo Drive. Additionally, approval was given if other temporary street closures are deemed necessary by BHPD for the driving tour.

- b. Funding was supported for a \$199,150 base level, plus the \$29,820 Option "A" for Video Monitors, Camera Package, Switching Equipment, Set Up & Coordination for a total of \$228,970.
- c. The fees for the street closures will be waived, as was done in 2019.
- d. The street pole banners fabrication and installation will be funded. The Liaisons will work directly with the organizers on the street pole banner designs.
- e. Funding was also supported for ads by the City in local newspapers.
