Section 1 – Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program: Background Information

The City of Beverly Hills is committed to working with residents to protect and preserve neighborhood livability through traffic calming. Traffic calming is the implementation of physical design elements and other strategies to reduce speeding and/or cut-through vehicle traffic in residential neighborhoods. As part of a Safe System Approach to transportation safety, the City strives to create street designs that “self-enforce” proper vehicle speeds, rather than primarily relying on enforcement.

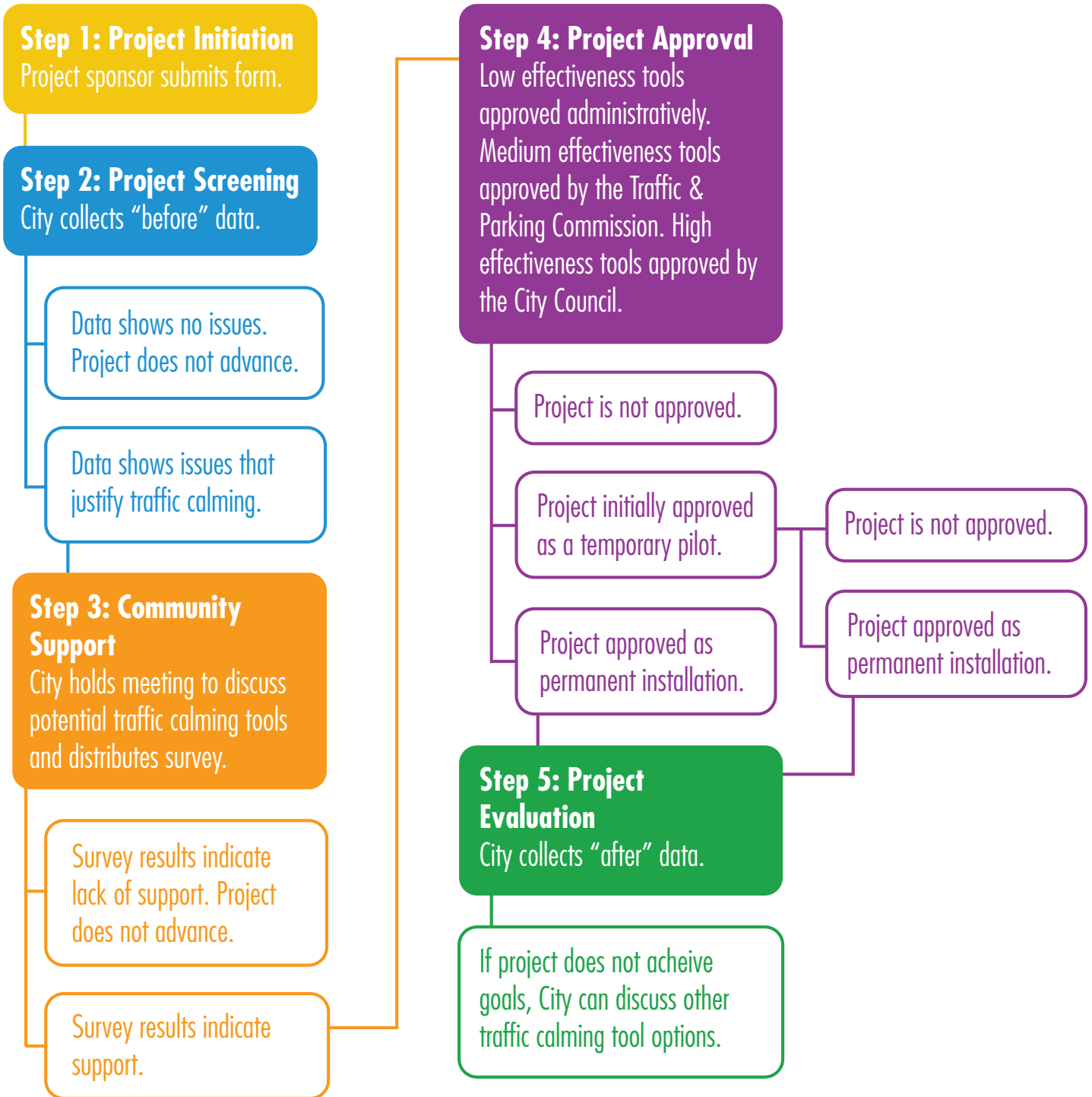
The City’s Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP) was approved by City Council in November 2023 and is available for review at: www.beverlyhills.org/TrafficCalming. The NTCP includes two sections: (1) Traffic Calming Toolbox, and (2) Policies and Procedures. The Traffic Calming Toolbox identifies a menu of available devices for residents to request on their street block(s). The Policies and Procedures outline the process for residents to seek approval for installation of traffic calming devices. Residents interested in applying for traffic calming on their street block(s) should review both sections of the NTCP to assist in completion of this form.

Following submittal of this application form, City staff will gather data to determine if traffic calming is justified on the identified street block(s). If a project passes the screening process, the City will work with residents to identify recommended traffic calming and solicit community support. If there is support, the project will advance to review by the approving body, as outlined in Policies and Procedures and shown in the graphic on the following page.
