a. Initiative Subcommittees Updates:

1. Next Night 2018

 Next Night 2018 Subcommittee Chair Cory Charlupski updated the Committee on the chosen date of the event, the proposed budget and the timeline for presenting to City Council.

2. Next Gen Housing

 Next Gen Housing Subcommittee Chair Alex Polin shared an update that the team has expanded and members have attended City-hosted educational workshops on current rent policies. ii. Councilmember Wunderlich discussed the Costa Hawkins Rental Housing Act and the role it has played in California housing policy.
