• **Position title:** Next Beverly Hills Community Liaison

• Structure: Up to 2 liaisons per category

• Categories: 11 total (see list attached)

• **Term:** 1 year, starting May 23

• Time commitment: 1-5 hours per week (at your discretion)

• Responsibilities:

- 1. Consume information in your category from City bodies, City reports, community leaders, community organizations, and news sources.
- Report noteworthy developments in your category at NBH committee meetings (concise 3 minute reports, including answering any questions).
- 3. Represent NBH in your category at City and community meetings and events, when needed.

• Benefits:

- Prestige of holding a leadership position on a prominent City of Beverly Hills committee.
- O Ability to cite this position as relevant leadership experience for future professional and civic leadership opportunities.
- o Access to the latest and most important civic information.
- Opportunity to build relationships with top City and community leaders.
- Opportunity to grow your leadership skills, including information gathering, organization, presentations, teamwork, and more.

• Recommended actions (we will assist you in locating this information):

- Attend City Council meetings.
- Attend relevant Commission and Committee meetings.
- o Engage with relevant City and community organizations.
- o Follow relevant leaders and organizations on social media.
- o Signup for relevant alerts and newsletters.
- o Read local newspapers.
- Restriction: Due to potential functional and logistical conflicts, current Commissioners cannot serve as Community Liaisons in the same area as their Commission. For example, a Fine Art Commissioner cannot serve as our Arts Liaison. However, they can serve in any unrelated category. This is to avoid situations where NBH needs to present to a Commission but is unable to because the relevant Community Liaison sits on the Commission; or situations where NBH votes to advocate to a Commission on a certain position that's in conflict with the individual stance of a Commissioner who also serves as the relevant Community Liaison.
