Beverly Hills Dog Park Extends Hours

Dog Park Permit Holders Can Enjoy the Park More with Longer Hours

Beverly Hills, Calif. – The City of Beverly Hills has extended its hours for the Community Dog Park, located at 344 North Foothill Road in Beverly Hills. The dog park is now open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, giving people an extra three hours during prime time usage. “We have many people who like taking their dogs out early in the morning and late at night, so we are meeting the needs of the community,” says Nancy Hunt-Coffey, Community Services Director.

The Beverly Hills Dog Park opened in September of 2016. To date, 1,795 dogs are registered to use the park and over 35,500 visitors have been recorded.

To utilize the dog park, please register online at www.beverlyhills.org/dogpark. All registered dogs will be issued a Beverly Hills permit tag and soon owners will be issued a key fob for the new keyless entry system that will be installed. Once the system is installed, current users will be provided with information about how to utilize the system. The permits are free and the online process makes it easy and fast to apply.

All dogs must have a valid license in their local community to apply for dog park permit tag - for Beverly Hills residents, that is the City of L.A. This ensures that the dogs in the park are healthy and current on their rabies vaccination.
