



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Dear Residents,

The City of Beverly Hills has contracted with Superior Pavement Markings, Inc. to install new bike lanes and sharrows on Doheny Drive between Burton Way and Whitworth Drive. This project was approved by City Council on June 21, 2022.

What to Expect:

No parking signs. Some street parking will be impacted during striping activity.

Traffic control devices such as cones and delineators. Flagger operations will allow one lane of traffic through from each direction when necessary.

A crew of 3-6 people, utility truck, pick-up truck, and striping truck.

New striping layout placement will take approximately 3 days.

Crews will accommodate access into or out of your driveway or garage.

The project will not include permanent removal of travel lanes or parking spaces.

*Schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions or other unforeseeable circumstances.

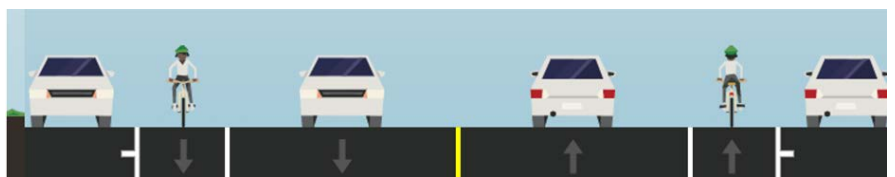
Work Hours: 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
