Smart Thermostats & Battery Energy Storage Program Options for Residential Customers

Earn money while helping to create a cleaner environment and healthier communities.

Customers with smart thermostats or battery energy storage systems can receive financial incentives for modifying their energy equipment use during times of peak energy demand between 4-9pm on weekdays.

Program benefits

Earn incentive payments and potentially reduce your monthly energy bill



See your energy savings through the Olivine Community App



Reduce pollution and greenhouse gases

Help reduce strain on the grid during times of peak demand



To be eligible you must:

- Be a Clean Power Alliance residential customer
- Have a smart thermostat or battery energy storage system connected to the internet
- Agree to modify your energy usage in response to up to 5 energy savings events per month

Master metered customers and customers enrolled in other third party demand response programs, Medical Baseline Allowance, or SCE's Summer Discount Plan (SDP) are not eligible to enroll in CPA Power Response unless they disenroll from those programs. Rewards and enrollment are limited to one person per household. Earn \$100 for enrolling_and get an additional \$100 yearly participation reward.

Higher incentives available for CARE/FERA customers and customers located in targeted low-income areas.

How does the CPA Power Response program work?

Enroll in the program through the Olivine Community App and receive enrollment reward

Smart Thermostats

Smart thermostats can enable energy savings by allowing users to remotely control their heating and cooling settings from a computer or a smartphone (e.g. Nest and Ecobee).

Available to Clean Power Alliance customers.



Battery energy storage allows energy to be retained and used at a later time.

•Available to Clean Power Alliance customers with existing solar-paired or standalone battery energy storage systems from qualified vendors/ battery management system suppliers.

•Event participation is flexible but you must participate in at least 50% of the events annually to receive participation incentives.
